1. There is no peace comparable to the peace of God.

- “Let the peace of Christ”
- Contrasting worldly peace with God's peace (John 14:27)
- The God of peace (Romans 15:33; 16:20; Philippians 4:9; 1 Thessalonians 5:23; Hebrews 13:20)
- More than a slogan (2 Peter 1:2; Colossians 3:16)



2. Peace is part of the high calling of God upon every believer's life.

- “you were called to peace”
- Peace-making is a divine work (Matthew 5:9)
- Producing peace is a fruit of the Holy Spirit's work in our lives (Galatians 5:22)



- It takes work to live in peace (Hebrews 12:14)
- Pursuing peace (1 Peter 3:10-11)

3. Allow the peace of God to govern your heart.

- “Let the peace of God rule in your hearts”



- Perfect peace (Isaiah 26:3)
- The peace patrol (Philippians 4:6-7)
- Uninterrupted and unconventional peace (2 Thessalonians 3:16)
