

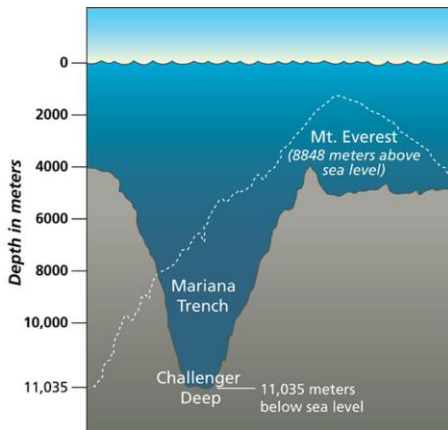
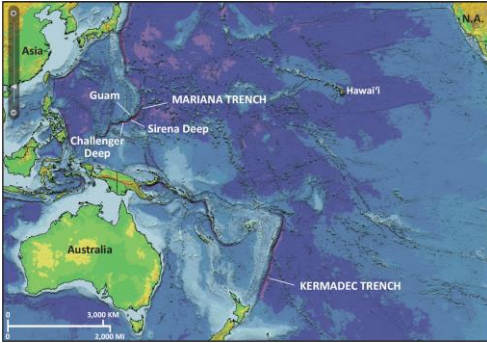

2 Chronicles 7:14 NIV

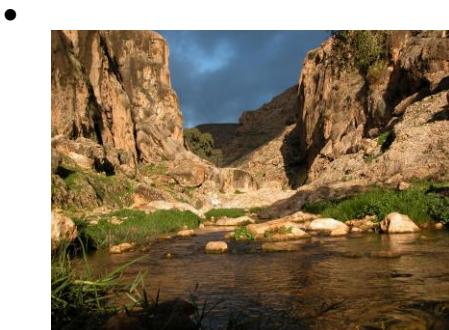
